ATTENTION ALL SUB-CONTRACTORS

- ❖ We expect all sub-contractors to be good representatives of Carbon River Homes.
- ❖ Compliance with Washington Administrative Code 296 required of every employer on this job site.
- ❖ Prior to the start of any work, we require the following: A current Certificate of Insurance (minimum coverage for "each occurrence" must be \$500,000.00 with CRC listed as an additional insured) on file and a signed Subcontract.
- ❖ Tracking or staining of the roads is prohibited not only by the Contractor but by new Federal and State Erosion laws that took effect as of October 1st, 2006. Subcontractors are required to be familiar with The State of Washington Water Pollution Control Law Chapter 90.48 Revised Code of Washington and The Federal Water Pollution Control Act (The Clean Water Act) Title 33 United States Code, Section 1251 et seq.
- ❖ Be mindful of occupied homes and home owners.
- ❖ All traffic laws and noise ordinances apply on this job site.
- ❖ Respect finished homes.
- ❖ Do not park in front of occupied homes.
- ❖ Work safely or work elsewhere.
- ❖ **Clean up and recycling daily is mandatory not optional, this includes the crawl.**
- ❖ Booties required in all finished homes, no exceptions.
- ❖ No smoking or eating in home after drywall.
- ❖ Failure to comply with these rules could result in monetary damages or a release from contract.
