SUBCONTRACTOR REQUIREMENTS

The following five items must be submitted prior to the start of any work.

- Certificate of Insurance naming Carbon River Construction Company as a "Named Insured". Minimum coverage for "Each Occurrence" must be \$500,000.
- Federal W-9 Form, "Request for Taxpayer Identification Number and Certification".
{NOTE: IF YOU ARE EXEMPT FROM BACKUP WITHHOLDINGS
(i.e. YOU DON'T RECEIVE 1099 FORMS) YOU MUST COMPLETE PART II OF FORM W9.}
- Current Workers Compensation Account (if applicable)
- Signed Subcontract to be on file with the office.
- Written Bid to include the following info; date of bid, development name, scope of work to be performed and pricing.

Due to third party lawsuits, "Stute decision", this company must pay close attention to the safety programs of our subcontractors. This decision makes the General Contractor responsible for the safety of all employees at the worksite, whether it is subcontractor employees or the General Contractor's employees. For this reason, we require that the subcontractor follow the criteria listed below.

- Written accident prevention program (submit to Carbon River Homes).

The following documentation should be readily available upon request from Carbon River Homes.

- Past Years OSHA 200 Form.
- Safety meetings minutes held a minimum of once a month.
- Documentation of jobsite inspections conducted on a weekly basis.
